PASTORS PARTNER IN YOUTH PROJECT *Pilgrim and Tabernacle: United In Praise & Service*

In July, 2005, while still in Atlanta, Rev. Dr. Kenneth R. Board had preached a message entitled, *“The Power of Oneness”*, to the youth group at Tabernacle Baptist Church in Carrollton, Georgia, of which Dr. James “Jimmy” F. Gentry is pastor. That message set off a dialogue between the two pastors about youth groups and community outreach. After Rev. Board moved to Rockford as Senior Pastor of the Pilgrim Baptist Church in the fall of 2005, that dialogue continued — and then expanded to include a possible joint youth ministry partnership in Rockford. A delegation from Tabernacle visited Rockford in January, 2006 to further explore such a ministry partnership.

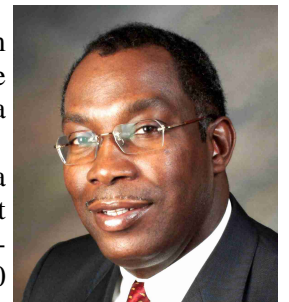
During the week of July 1, 2006, that dialogue will bear fruit in Rockford as the two pastors, youth groups, and youth leaders come together on a special Joint Youth Project with the

mission *“to engage our youth and adult volunteers in outreach service to the Southwest Rockford Community and to the Rockford Rescue Mission, while establishing a Christ-centered bond between the churches.”*

Dr. Gentry has been pastor of the 2,600-member Tabernacle Baptist Church since year 2000 and had previously pastored churches in Tennessee and in his native state of Kentucky. Dr. Gentry holds a Bachelor's Degree in Religious Studies and History from Western Kentucky University and a Doctor of Ministry degree from The Southern Baptist Theological Seminary, Louisville, Kentucky. He and his wife, Mrs. Jacqueline “Jackie” Gentry, are parents of a son and daughter.

Before coming to Rockford as Senior Pastor of Pilgrim Baptist Church, Dr. Board had served as Assistant Pastor at the historic Ebenezer Baptist Church in Atlanta where he had been a member since 1987.

Born in Shreveport, Louisiana, Rev. Board earned a BBA Degree in Management and Marketing from Northeast Louisiana University, Monroe. He received his Master of Divinity Degree in 1995 and his Doctor of Ministry Degree in 2000 from the Interdenominational Theological Center in Atlanta. He has 20-plus years of management experience with AT&T/Bell South and as President/CEO of KENMAR Global Consulting. Pastor Board’s world-wide travels add to his more than 30 years’ experience in Christian leadership, congregational nurturing, and outreach. He and his wife, Mrs. Marilyn Board, have three sons and two daughters.

YOUTH MISSION PROJECT

The ultimate goal of the Pilgrim & Tabernacle Youth Mission Project, as expressed by Pastor Board, is — *“to win souls for Jesus Christ (conversions); to lead Christians into a deeper relationship with God and each other; and to glorify God in our efforts”* — using four major components:

1) Entertainment and Fun; 2) Christian Teaching & Discipleship Training; 3) Evangelism; and 4) Community Outreach.

The youth and leaders of both churches have planned an ambitious week from Saturday, July 1, through Friday, July 7. Along with entertainment and fun, the youth will engage in Bible study, evangelism training, door-to-door sharing of information, doing light work for senior citizens in the Pilgrim community, sorting goods and clothing at Rockford Rescue Mission’s resale shops, and ministering at Rockford Rescue Mission Sunday evening, July 2, by providing a meal and church service. The youths’ activities will culminate in a sightseeing trip to Chicago on Friday, July 7.

PILGRIM'S VAN MINISTRY

Pilgrim is blessed to have some special ministries that serve the needs of Pilgrim members and the community, many of which we rarely hear about or think about. One such special ministry is the Van Ministry.

Some of us may take it for granted that when we want to go somewhere, we just get into our cars or SUV's, back out of the garage — and go! How often do we ever stop to wonder how some of the people worshipping with us in church get there or get back home? What if they don't have a vehicle or, for whatever reason, are unable to drive?

The actual fact is that our church van delivers up to 15 people to Pilgrim each Sunday for our morning worship service, from both the east and west sides of Rockford, and then returns them back home!

Pilgrim's Van Ministry started about ten years ago with the purchase of two vans, one with a 15-person capacity and a smaller one with special accommodations. Unfortunately, for some time now, the van with special accommodations has been out of service, and we have only one volunteer driver, Mr. Lamar White.

The good news is that the smaller van is currently being repaired and refitted with more seats. The goal is to provide transportation to other church events such as Sunday School, Prayer Meeting, Bible Study, and Youth Programs. Putting the second van into service, though, means the need for more drivers.

If you observe this ministry closely, you will find that the people who depend on this service have formed a close Christian bond with each other and with Lamar White. The riders interviewed all stated that they would be hard pressed to find a way to and from church without the service provided our Van Ministry.

Some passengers also commented on Brother Lamar's dedication, patience, and compassion. They say he drives even when he does not feel well and tries to accommodate some special needs — *for instance, stopping to pick up a needed item at a store on the way home or waiting for some who want to attend an after-church event* — without incurring undue expense to the church. Letha Adams says, *"He will always let us know ahead of time if he can't pick us up."*
