## "ANGEL TREE" — 2006

Pilgrim Baptist Church's Jail Ministry works hand in hand with the National Prison Fellowship's "Angel Tree" Ministry to deliver the gift of love and a message of hope to children of prisoners. This year, Pilgrim Baptist Church's goal is again to sponsor 100 children.



There is so much joy that comes with sharing Christ's love with kids who have a mom or dad in prison. If you are new to Pilgrim, the Angel Tree ministry gives churches an opportunity to share Christ's love by helping to meet the physical, emotional, and spiritual needs of the families of prisoners. Participating in "Angel Tree" is a powerful way for our church to lovingly answer the Biblical call to minister to the "least of these."

On **Sunday, November 19**, we will host our Annual "Hope Luncheon" in the lower level after morning worship, to which everyone is invited. At that time, you can help in one of three ways:

- (1) Sponsor a child by selecting a name from the "Angel Tree" in the lower lever and then purchasing two gifts for the child — an article of clothing and a fun gift;
- (2) Make a monetary donation toward the purchase of the gifts for a child; or
- (3) Be available to deliver the gifts once they are purchased and returned to the church.

The aim of an "Angel Tree Christmas" is to connect parents in prison with their children through the delivery of Christmas gifts on behalf of the absent parent.
