Excerpts from "Pastor's Corner"

"The Lenten Season is a **40-day period before Easter** which, this year, was from March 9 to April 23, the day before Easter.

"It is a season of soul searching and repentance, as many fast from certain foods, drinks, habits, etc., as a way to cleanse themselves.

"In most churches, the decorations are purple, the royal color, to prepare for the King, our Lord, Jesus the Christ, and also white, which symbolizes the forgiveness of sins and new birth in Jesus."



Easter Lilies commemorate the Resurrection of Jesus Christ and are symbolic of such attributes as purity, innocence, hope, and life. The above Lilies gracing Pilgrim's altar were selected and arranged by **Mrs. Nanelle Due** who ensures fresh flowers for the altar each Sunday.



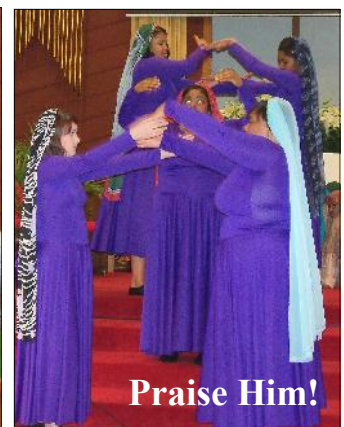
"HE'S NOT DEAD!"

The renown *Kantorei, Singing Boys of Rockford*, (upper right) performed to an appreciative, full-house audience at Pilgrim on April 10.

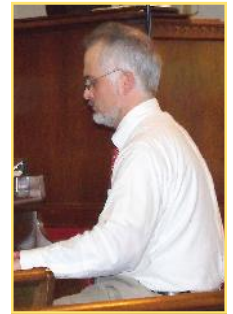

Maundy Thursday Feast

The Annual Maundy Thursday Feast at Pilgrim by the *Lydians Ministry* at 6 p.m. on April 21 was again a beautiful and solemn commemoration of Christ's last meal.

In the photo at right are *Pastor Kenneth R. Board*, who presided at the head of the tables which were laid out in the shape of the Cross, and *First Lady Marilyn Board*.

Pastor Board explained the term "Maundy" (mourning) and the significance of the symbolic foods--lamb, grain, fruit, bitter herbs, egg, and unleavened bread. After the prayers, scriptures, and meal, Pastor Board led the rite of Holy Communion.



Scriptures were read by selected individuals as worshipers dined in reverent silence.

Pack 25 Returns to Pilgrim!

During Pilgrim's Men's Day worship on March 27, **Judge Patrick Yarbrough** and **Mr. Everette Sherrod**, District Director for the Blackhawk Area Council, BSA, presented one plan for saving our young boys from the streets and gang recruitment--by becoming a Scout! Judge Yarbrough shared statistics and reasons our children can so easily be recruited by gangs or fall into other destructive life choices

Everette Sherrod gave a history of Scouting in Rockford's African-American community. The first such troop was started on February 25, 1925, at Pilgrim--which was then Pilgrim Rest Baptist Church at 618 Morgan Street. **Rev. W. R. Jackson** was the Pastor as well as the Scoutmaster for Troop 25.

Over the years, Allen Chapel A.M.E. Church became involved, and the Troop was ultimately chartered to Booker Washington Community Center. A Cub Scout Pack 25 also existed at Booker which was the feeder pack for Troop 25, but it ceased in 1965. When a Pack or Troop drops, it allows another unit to use the un-registered number. Mr. Sherrod said it is ironic that no

one at present has Pack or Troop No. 25, which he hopes is a sign for Pilgrim to once again take the reins and run the Cub Scout Pack and eventually a Boy Scout Troop at the church.

During that Men's Day service, **Pastor Kenneth R. Board** made an appeal for volunteers to get this effort up and running, and plans are currently under way. A tentative start date is May 21 for Cub Scout Pack 25 at Pilgrim!

Mr. Sherrod offered support from the Council in the launching of Pack 25, which he said will be named in memory of the late **James E. Towns** for his 60-plus years in Scouting. In his research about Pack 25, Mr. Sherrod said a question was posed in the file: "**How had boys been organized previously?**" The answer was "**Sunday School Class!**"
