Celebrations of Pilgrim's 95th Anniversary during August, 2012 reaffirmed the legacy of faithfulness handed down by pastors and members since 1917.

Common threads were woven into each of six worship services by those who prepared the anniversary worship programs.

Guest preachers delivered messages of faith by encouraging Pilgrim to continue putting God first! Members and visitors participated in a special litany and congregational song, "Great is Thy Faithfulness."

Examples were given in each service about Pilgrim's historical and current efforts in areas such as Education (*Ray Cooper*); Missions (*Vivette Hall*); Discipleship (*Minister David Sidney*); Social Justice & Political Activism (*Eldridge Gilbert, Jr.*); and Economic Empowerment (*Victory Bell*).

Musicians, choirs, and "Unlimited Praise" celebrated with music and dance.



In late 2005, Rev. Dr. Kenneth R. Board heeded God's call to become Senior Pastor of Pilgrim Baptist Church to continue His plan for Pilgrim and the Rockford community.

The community participated in celebrations by attending "Jazz on the Lawn-2012" and other events.

With packed bags, snacks, and prayer, several of our high-school youth and Youth Group Leaders traveled to Washington, D.C. for the American Baptist Churches IMMERSE 2012 Youth Conference and Missions Trip. Pilgrim Baptist Church youth and leaders met other local churches in Bloomington and Springfield, IL and traveled together on two coach buses.

Our days in D.C. were packed! Averaging 5-1/2 to 6 hours of sleep each night, we began with breakfast at 6:30 a.m. and ended the day by Mid-night.

New friendships were formed while in D.C., with some commenting on how, for the first time, they could just be themselves with other followers of Jesus Christ! London Smith describes the trip as "life changing." She has shared her own comments.

Each day began and ended with a worship service and powerful sermons challenging all to be "full-on" for God, to discover their purpose in life, and to live it out with courage. The most powerful night of the trip was Thursday, July 26, with over 280 youth and youth leaders committing or rededicating their lives to Jesus Christ, with some accepting the call to full-time ministry.

Other days including picking collard greens for a local farmer to serve homeless and low-income families; a prayer walk on the National Mall, and outreach activities at a local community center.

As a member and Minister of Pilgrim, I am very excited about what God is up to in the lives of our youth! Please continue to pray for, love, and support our youth!
