Two Pilgrim Ministers receive Masters of Divinity Degrees from Northern Theological Seminary

The 2014 graduation for Northern Baptist Theological Seminary of Lombard, Illinois was held in Hammer-schmidt Chapel on the grounds of Elmhurst College on Saturday, June 7, 2014. Pilgrim was blessed to have two graduates, Minister Carmen Jordan and Minister Sharon Olson, who received Masters of Divinity degrees.

Pilgrim was doubly honored as these two ministers also received two of the three awards given!

Minister Olson earned the highest award (*the Academic Award*) for having the highest grade point average, 4.0 out of 4.0 -- a perfect score. This is a rarity in seminary because of the complexity and diversity of courses and internships. Minister Jordan received the *Best Preacher Award*.

Of course, we are so proud of them, and God is so good! They have worked so hard, and I am very grateful! Go Pilgrim! Go Ministers Jordan & Olson!

After graduation, Minister Sharon Olson and her husband, Dr. Mitchell Olson, hosted a small celebratory luncheon party which Pilgrim Minister Carl L. Towns, Lady Marilyn, and I attended near Elmhurst College.
