MAUNDY THURSDAY: The annual "Maundy Thursday Feast" sponsored by the Lydians Ministry was held at 6:00 p.m. Thursday, April 17. This event symbolizes the Last Supper before Jesus was betrayed and crucified. Guests silently dined on symbolic foods by candlelight and participated in Holy Communion led by Pastor Board. Individuals read pre-selected scriptures during the meal.

Pastor's 20th Ordination Anniversary!

Pastor Board was surprised on Sunday, April 13, with honor for 20th Ordination Year.

(Excerpts from Comments by Minister Sharon Olson)

"It was [the Lord] who gave some to be apostles, some to be prophets, some to be evangelists, and some to be pastors and teachers, to prepare God's people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up . . ." Ephesians 4:11, 12

This scripture in many ways adequately describes our Senior Pastor, Rev. Dr. Kenneth R. Board. He is a teacher, an equipper of the saints, a builder up of the body of Christ, and last, but not least, a loving and caring pastor.

This year, Pastor Board was surprised as the congregation helped to celebrate his 20th anniversary of becoming ordained to serve in pastoral ministry. Ordination is a lifelong honor that is bestowed on someone whom God has called to lead others within the church and who has demonstrated the gifts necessary to do so.

No one can ordain himself. The church congregation and denomination have to confirm that the person is worthy to fulfill the calling of the pastorate. When Pastor Board was ordained 20 years ago, other pastors laid hands on him, prayed for him, and conferred on him the same honor and responsibility that they, themselves, had been given.

Since then, Pastor Board has shown himself to be Faithful, Available, and Teachable (FAT); and, by the power of the Holy Spirit, his pastoral gifts have grown and multiplied many times over.

A pastor is another word for shepherd--someone who cares for the sheep on behalf of the Lord. If Pastor Board has ever visited you during your illness; prayed for or



prophesied over you; attended an event you were in; written a reference for you or helped you fight for a job; attended a college audition for you; given you one of his bear hugs; or you have heard him say "Glory!" at a moment of victory in your life . . . then you know that he is indeed a faithful and loving shepherd of this house and of all the people within it!

Lady Marilyn Board joined Pastor Board for the many presentations, as ministry is a partnership between them. Pastor Board's pastor, Rev. Ed Libby, gave a prayer of encouragement; monetary love gifts were received along with a trophy and certificate from ABC Great Rivers Region; the choir sang his favorite song; and "Unlimited Praise" performed his favorite dance!
