BRIEF HISTORY

The "Pilgrim Rest Baptist Church" was organized in 1917 and grew under the leadership of several pastors. During subsequent years, the "Rest" was deleted from the name. The current edifice at 1703 South Central Avenue was completed in March, 1961, under the leadership of the late Rev. Dr. E.H.E. Gilbert who served as Pastor for 44 years. In 1990, Rev. Steve Bland was called as Pastor and served 14 years. Pilgrim's current Senior Pastor and Servant Leader, Rev. Dr. Kenneth R. Board, accepted the call in September, 2005. Each leader has added to Pilgrim's direction and leadership in the community.

Under Pastor Board's leadership, the church has grown physically, financially, and spiritually; and by faithfully following our vision, we can joyfully say, "And still we rise!" **To God Be the Glory!**

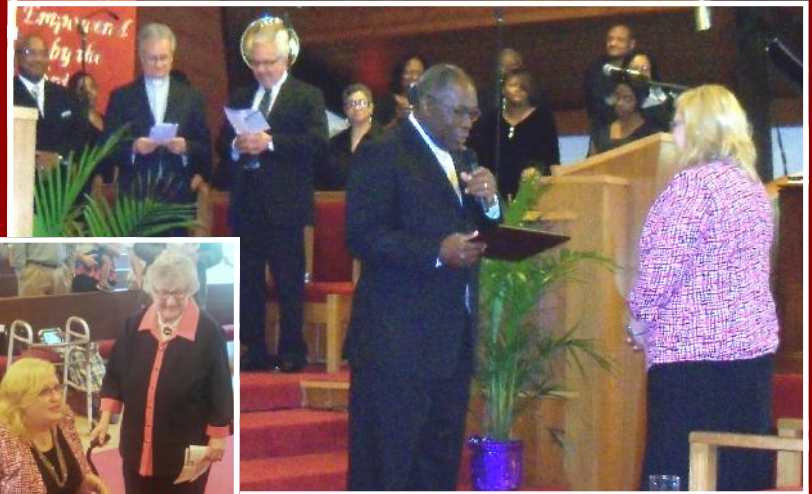
CHILDREN ATTEND COVENANT HARBOR BIBLE CAMP**By Lorraine Wilson (Pilgrim Administrative Assistant)**

During a service at 4:00 p.m. on Sunday, July 20, 2014, Reverend Sharon M. Olson was ordained. The Rev. Dr. Kenneth R. Board, Senior Pastor of Pilgrim Baptist Church, presided and preached the ordination sermon.



A number of clergy from Pilgrim and other churches participated in this service of ordination. Two preachers shared greetings at the ordination via video: Rev. Sharon M. Olson accepted Christ and was baptized at age 8 and is the daughter of two American Baptist pastors, the late Rev. David Thompson and Rev. Clara Thompson, who retired at age 75 from chaplaincy work. Sharon's deep love of church has extended throughout her life.

She earned her Bachelor of Arts degree from Wheaton College in 1982, where she met her husband, (Dr.) Mitch Olson. After 32 years, they have two grown daughters and two foster sons, Tray and T.J., whom they hope to adopt. In June, 2014, Minister Olson received her Master of Divinity Degree from Northern Baptist Seminary in Lombard, Illinois, and received the highest academic award. Since 2010, she has served with Pilgrim's volunteer clergy and in many leadership roles, including Pilgrim's Leadership Council and Grief and Loss Support Ministry.

As the result of a vote of affirmation during a Church Family meeting, Rev. Olson is now Pilgrim's Assistant Pastor.

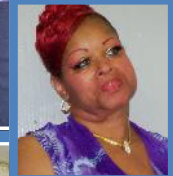
