# Mission Summit-2013

Pilgrim's First Lady & Delegate to the American Baptist Biennial Gathering

I am grateful for the privilege of representing Pilgrim as a delegate at the American Baptist 2013 Biennial/Mission Summit held June 21-23, 2013. The setting was in beautiful Overland Park, Kansas, a suburb of Kansas City. It was a rich experience filled with worship, fellowship, knowledge sharing, and mission work!

The delegation attending was made up of American Baptists from around the world! The rich diversity of people seemed remarkably representative of the "great number that will one day surround the Throne."

The opening worship featured Native Americans attired in native garb dancing in praise to the Lord's Prayer, with a symbolic fanning of smoke to purify and cleanse the worshippers as well as the building so that we could properly "set the atmosphere" for worship.

A Mission Summit is a gathering of people who talk about how God is currently active in their lives and communities. Small group conversations are at the heart of the Summit, and participants gather around a common theme to explore the question: "What can we create together to respond to the call of Christ today in this area of ministry?" The entire Mission Summit is about dynamic conversation, not lecture.

The topics are inclusive of the everyday challenges facing Christians and Churches in the 21st Century; and the key is that,

together, we will discern the will and direction of God so we can be effective in the work that He has called us to do in reaching the world for Him.

One of the personal highlights for me was the opportunity to engage in mission work. I worked elbow to elbow with my brothers and sisters to prepare over 7,050 meals for tornado victims in Moore, Oklahoma. Of course, we began and finished our work in prayer. Our view of the less fortunate was challenged as we watched interviews with those who were less fortunate. Still ringing in my ears

is the challenge to remember these words: "Your liberation is bound to mine. Lack of goods is a symptom. Today, we packaged meals; what you do later is up to you!"

The Biennial/Mission Summit is an opportunity to worship with our brothers and sisters from around the world, heed Christ's call for unity as we work together to seek transformation, and to be on mission for Christ! (The next summit will be in 2015.)

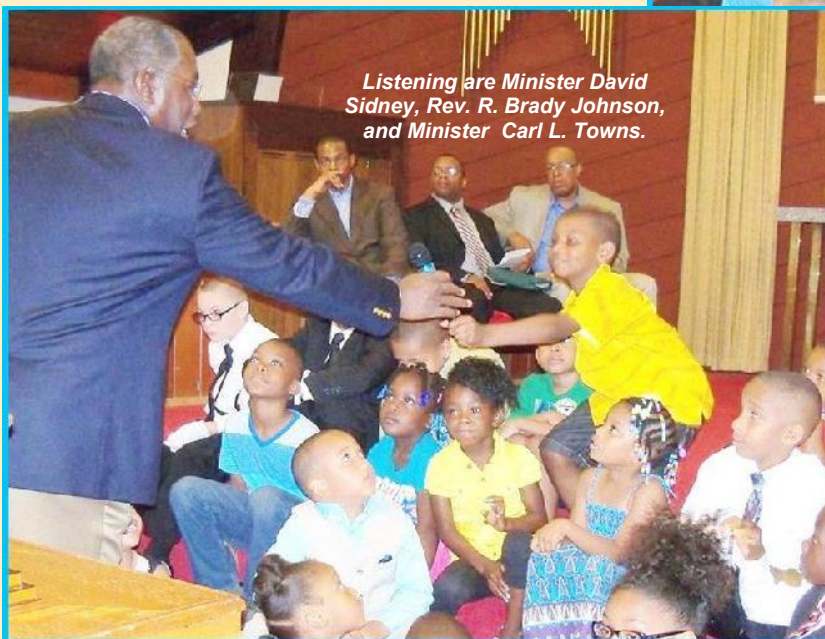

Thanks to the excellent leadership in Children's Church, these young people are confident with their responses and speak boldly into the microphone.

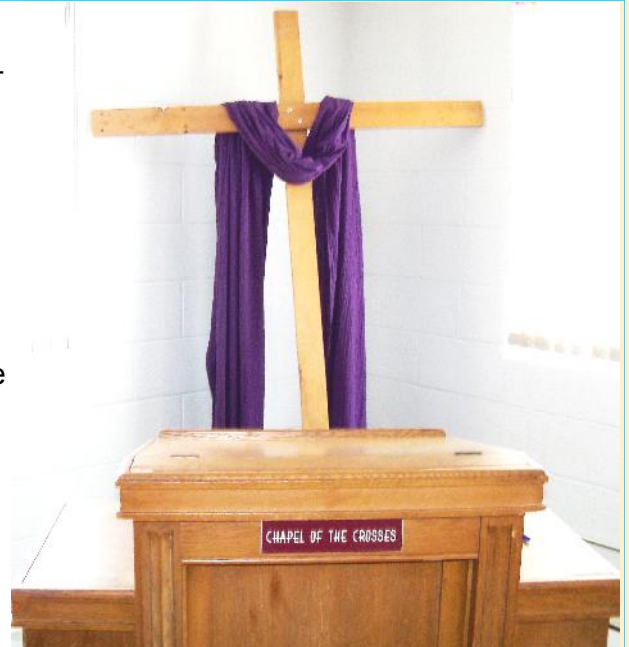
Many adults say they enjoy the sermons and are especially blessed by the powerful simplicity of the children's comments!

Pilgrim's Sunday morning worship begins at 10:30 a.m. in the main Sanctuary. Children's Church is held simultaneously downstairs in the Chapel of the Crosses for ages 4 through 12, except for the first Sunday when they are in the main Sanctuary for Communion.

This ministry is led by Deacon Christopher Morris and Deaconess Albara Morris, who is also Pilgrim's Sunday School Superintendent. Minister David Sidney directs Pilgrim's Children and Youth Ministry (CYM) programs.

Children's Church is structured with worship, singing, Biblical study, and a brief sermon by a Clergy member. The children freely participate in discussions; and, as Minister Sharon Olson said, *"They ask probing questions!"*

During this summer break in routine, the CYM leaders are reviewing plans for resuming Children's Church in the fall. Since the children are in the main sanctuary each first Sunday, Pastor Board has said that Clergy members will continue to deliver sermons to them on that day.
